Students grades must be certified after the student's first semester, senior-year grades are posted. The number of scholarships available WILL BE LIMITED AND DETERMINED BY AVAILABLE FUNDS. Only ONE scholarship per student may be awarded. Students will ONLY be considered for scholarships after both this application and FAFSA results are received by MTC.

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS
